Wild Wanderers leaders must carry Mobile Phones (and have each others numbers), and a serviced First aid kit. Ensure all the above know where to direct emergency services and who the trained first aiders are.

- In any event Wild Wanderers Education leaders must seek and abide by teachers and group leaders first aid and child protection guidance.
- During activities where Wild Wanderers Education leaders are in sole charge they must ensure all children are at least eight years old and carry parental consent forms for all the children in their care. They must have up to date first aid and CRB certificates.
- Before the commencement of each session a note must be made in the risk assessment daybook of the age group, special needs, allergies or learning disabilities within the group, and of any irregular potential hazards in the activities or places to be used.
- During extreme weather leaders must ensure all people have access to regular, appropriate drinks and be wearing adequate clothing. Children must be closely watched for chilling or over heating and sunburn.
- Children must be closely supervised and kept in distinct groups when in public places, car parks and when crossing internal roads.

Paper copies of relevant risk assessments will follow.

Please can all relevant special needs, allergies, medication or learning disabilities within the group be documented by a teacher from the school visiting Wild Wanderers.
